
## FOSTER HOME CONTRACT

Inis FOSTER HOME CONTRACT is entered into thisday of,  20
Between SOUTHEAST GERMAN SHEPHERD RESCUE and(Hereinafter called "Foster Parent".)
The Southeast German Shepherd Rescue is interested in the welfare of the Animal(s) placed in the care of the Foster Parent. In order to ensure these objectives, the Southeast German Shepherd Rescue (SGSR) and the foster parent jointly agree to the following:
SGSR agrees to transfer the Animal to the Foster Parent with all accompanying paperwork contained in a SGSR Foster Folder.
Foster Parent agrees to obey all applicable laws governing and custody of Animals, including leash laws and barking control.
Foster Parent agrees not to keep the Animal(s) on leased or rented property where a "No Pets" policy is in force.
Foster Parent agrees to provide adequate fresh food and water, clean and dry shelter, and daily exercise. The Animal(s) must be kept in a clean, secure, fenced in yard or large kennel or kept indoors (crating optional) and relieved for outdoor exercise frequently Crates will be provided by the rescue upon request for use while the Animal(s) are in foster care.
SGSR will provide the Animal(s) with a collar, ID tag, and rabies tag which MUST be worn at all times.
Foster Parent will transport or arrange transport of the Animal(s) to the veterinarian. <b>SGSR will schedule ALL appointments, maintain communication with the vet, and pay for services.</b> Foster Parent will not discuss financial arrangements with the vet unless otherwise asked to do so by SGSR. <b>Foster Parent will not accept treatment and/or medications not previously approved by SGSR.</b>

Foster Parent will track required medical treatments (vaccinations, blood tests, heartworm preventative, heartworm treatment, spay/neuter, frontline administration, etc.) and contact SGSR prior to when shots, vet work, or prescriptions are due. SGSR will provide for all annual inoculations, de-worming treatments, heartworm preventative, frontline, and some medications.
Foster Parent will record and report to the Rescue all provided treatments, including services provided by the veterinarian when the bill is received. The Foster parent should track ALL treatments on the Dog Medical Record provided in the Foster Home Folder and retain all veterinary receipts so the adoptive family will have a permanent record.
Foster Parent agrees to be timely to veterinarian appointments and SGSR events. If the Foster Parent Must cancel or if they may be late, then the veterinarian or SGSR must be called in advance as a courtesy.
Foster Parent acknowledges that an event where the Animal(s) is present promotes the adoption of the Animal(s). However, if the Animal(s) is likely to cause injury to people or pets at an SGSR event, this must be reported to SGSR and the Animal(s) should not attend the function.
Foster Parent agrees to allow pre-approved SGSR adoptive families to contact them to discuss the Animal(s) (or vice versa) and arrange for visitation. Animals may only be adopted to pre-approved SGSR homes and under the supervision of SGSR. Foster Parent has the right to veto the adoption of the Animal(s) to a particular home if they feel it is not the most appropriate for the Animal(s). However, veto power must be used sparingly and for good reason.
Foster Parent will not "hold" any Animal(s) for an adoptive home without SGSR approval.
Foster Parent will forward the SGSR Adoption Contract, adoption fee, and all other SGSR paperwork to SGSR immediately after the placement of the foster dog with its forever family.
Foster parent will complete the SGSR Adoption Contract and include all requested information. Foster Parent will set a deadline for sterilizing the Animal(s) if this has not

already been done so. Any non-sterilized Animal(s) being placed on trial must have the approval of SGSR. Foster Parent will set a date for the "trial period", usually two weeks (14 days) from the adoption date. Foster parent will accurately describe the good and bad behavior of the dog so there are no surprises for the adoptive family. This is especially critical when destructive or vicious behavior is noticed. DISCLOSE ALL BEHAVIORS and the circumstances in which the behaviors occur to the adoptive family. Foster Parent will list all unusual conditions for the contract such as a longer trial period, SGSR paying for services that have not yet been performed, etc. Foster Parent will ensure that the adoptive home signs and dates the SGSR copy of the contract and collects the adoption fee.



Foster Parent agrees that participation as a SGSR Foster Home is voluntary and expressly agrees to assume the entire risk for any accidents or personal injury, including death, which might be sustained to persons, pets, and/or property as a result of participation in the SGSR Foster home program, and any negligent or willful neglect on their part in performing their duties.
Foster Parent further agrees to waive all benefits flowing from any state statute which would negate or limit the scope of this Contract and Indemnification Agreement.
I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS MEANS I AGREE TO BE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ANIMAL(S) IN MY CARE AND FOR ANY INJURY RESULTING TO PERSON, PETS, OR PROPERTY ARISING FROM, OR IN COMMECTION WITH, THE PERFORMANCE OF MY DUTIES WHILE A SGSR FOSTER ANIMAL(S) IS IN MY CARE.  By signing this Contract, I certify that I am 18 years of age or older and have read this Contract and fully understand it and that I am not relying on any statements or representations made by SGSR or their representatives.
